## Homeschooling for Christian Science Families

The Daycroft Online Learning Community (DOLC) provides a positive and supportive approach to homeschool education. The program offers a full curriculum for students

in any grade - from kindergarten all the way through high school. Students may also choose to enroll in select courses for credit recovery or to supplement traditional education. Character education is an integral part of the program, and parents can get to know each other through online parent meetings. An education specialist who is also a class-taught Christian Scientist offers support and guidance to both students and parents. Over 100 families have found that DOLC has met their need for an individualized educational program that supports their values and standards.

The National Leadership Council (NLC), one of DiscoveryBound's most sought-after programs, plays a significant role in the lives of many high school students. Now in its eighth year, the NLC is a multi-year servant leadership program, dedicated to fostering spiritual growth, leadership qualities, and a service approach to life. Students enter the program in mid-eighth grade and graduate in the middle of their senior year. In between, they are mentored by an adult Christian Scientist, develop close relationships with their NLC peers, work on community service projects, stretch themselves on an adventure trip, develop leadership skills, and consciously focus on growing spiritually. Due to interest and demand, the program has expanded, and over 200 teens have benefited from the program!

It's that time of year again! Campers and counselors from all over the country are anticipating being part of a summer camp family. For some, it will be the first experience with a large group of young Christian Scientists. ## **Charitable Giving**

The extended IRA charitable rollover legislation for 2013 allows individuals over age 70½ to directly transfer up to \$100,000 per year to one or more charities. Transferring an IRA distribution to a charity allows retirees to avoid paying income tax on the amount withdrawn, and these qualified charitable distributions can be used to satisfy IRA required minimum distributions.
